If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be relaxed from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. 7. **Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs):** Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service, and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted in case of product bids, whereas in case of services the eligibility is automatically validated. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

8. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price.

9. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

10. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -

1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost; or
3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost.

11. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. 9. **Buyer Added Bid Specific Scope Of Work(SOW)**

Text Clause(s)

Scope of Work

Internal Painting of Hostel Buildings & Other

The scope of work shall include internal painting including scraping, removal of oil/dirts, repair to wall and finishing the surface to achieve smooth finish of wall and ceiling surface of the buildings as per approved Schedule of Quantities (SoQ) specifications, directions of Engineer-in-Charge and site requirements. The contractor shall execute the services in a safe, systematic and professional manner ensuring completion within stipulated timelines.

The work broadly includes the following:

1. Internal Acrylic Emulsion Painting

- Surface preparation, cleaning, scraping, rubbing and making surface ready and applying primer (if required).
- Application of low VOC acrylic emulsion paint on walls/ceilings including additional coats wherever required to achieve uniform shade and finish.
- All materials, labour, tools, consumables and surface preparation complete. .

2. **Synthetic Enamel Painting**

- Painting of metal works, wooden surfaces with approved synthetic enamel paint.
- Surface preparation including removal of rust, loose paint, sanding and application of suitable primer wherever required.

General Scope and Contractor's Responsibilities

The contractor shall be fully responsible for the following:

A. Materials and Consumables

- Supply of all materials, paints, primers, sealants, compounds, fillers, consumables, tools and accessories required for complete execution of work.
- Only approved makes/brands conforming to relevant BIS/CPWD specifications shall be used.
- No substandard or diluted material shall be permitted.

B. Surface Preparation

- 1. The scope shall also include filling of cracks and surface imperfections; application of wall putty, wherever required; removal of stickers, dirt, oil stains, graffiti, and other surface contaminants; minor patch plaster repairs; correction and smoothing of sharp edges and corners; and thorough surface preparation by rubbing with sandpaper, buffing machine, or other approved methods before painting, as necessary, to achieve a smooth, even, and durable finish.
- 2. Protection of adjoining finished surfaces, furniture, fixtures, equipment, flooring, glazing, electrical fittings etc. from damage or paint splashes.

C. Labour, Machinery and Equipment

- Arrangement of skilled/semi-skilled labour, supervisors, painters, operators and technical personnel.
- Provision of all tools, tackles, grinders, spray machines, mixers, scaffolding, ladders, staging, boom lifts or any equipment required for safe and proper execution.

D. Scaffolding and Staging

- Safe scaffolding/staging arrangements for external and internal works including double scaffolding wherever required.
- Scaffolding shall comply with safety norms and shall not damage existing structures/finishes.

E. Safety and Statutory Compliance

- Contractor shall ensure compliance with all applicable labour laws, safety regulations and statutory provisions.
- Provision of PPEs such as helmets, safety belts, gloves, reflective jackets, masks, safety shoes etc. to workers.
- Barricading, caution signage and safety arrangements shall be provided at

work areas.

- Contractor shall be solely responsible for safety of workers, institute property and third parties during execution.

F. Quality Control and Specifications

- All works shall conform to approved specifications, manufacturer recommendations, CPWD specifications and directions of Engineer-in-Charge.
- Mock-ups/samples may be required for approval before bulk execution.
- Finished surface shall be uniform in shade, texture and appearance without visible brush marks, patches, cracks, waviness or peeling.

G. Cleaning and Disposal

- Daily cleaning of work area and proper disposal of debris, dismantled material, empty containers and waste outside campus/designated dumping area.
- Completion cleaning and handing over of finished areas in neat condition.

H. Working Conditions and Coordination

- Work may be required in occupied buildings including hostels and offices.
- Contractor shall plan activities to minimize disturbance to institute functioning.
- Necessary coordination with Engineer-in-Charge and user departments shall be maintained.

I. Timelines and Execution Schedule

- The contractor shall complete the work within stipulated contract period as per approved work schedule.
- Priority areas such as hostels facilities shall be completed during designated vacation/non-operational periods.
- Adequate manpower and resources shall be deployed to maintain progress.

J. Measurements and Rates

- Rates quoted shall be inclusive of all materials, labour, consumables, scaffolding, loading/unloading, transportation, GST, leads/lifts, wastages, safety arrangements, insurance, royalties, testing and all incidental charges required for complete execution of work.
- Nothing extra shall be paid beyond accepted rates unless specifically approved.

K. Defect Liability

- Contractor shall rectify defects such as peeling, blistering, cracking, shade variation, debonding or surface failure observed during defect liability period of minimum 6 months at no extra cost.

L. Approved Makes (Indicative)

Paints/coatings/materials shall generally be of approved makes or substantially equivalent such as:

- Paints & Putty: Asian /Dulux /Birla Opus/Berger/Nerolac

1.1 Registration & Statutory Compliance

1. The service provider must be a registered entity under Companies Act, 2013 / Partnership Act, 1932 / LLP Act, 2008 / Proprietorship.
2. The bidder must possess valid PAN and GSTIN.
3. The firm must be registered under the Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970 if applicable.
4. Must be an enlisted contractors of appropriate class & category of CPWD/MES/Railways/PWD(Haryana), INIs, PSUs, Equivalent Central or State Government Organization for carrying out Civil/Painting works/services.
5. Must have office at consignee state i.e Haryana State or Delhi NCR, Tri-city-Panchkula, Chandigarh & Mohali.
