With reference of Advt. No. NIDH/2021/01 dt. 29.04.2021, few queries have been received from prospective candidates. Clarifications on the queries are summarised below for the benefit of all such candidates:

S. No.	Queries	Clarifications
1.	Whether candidates working in Govt./ PSU/ Autonomous Bodies etc. are required to forward the application through proper channel? Do they have to attach NOC & Vigilance Clearance along with the application?	Yes. However, in case any candidate working in Government/ PSU/ Autonomous Bodies under Government is not able to obtain NOC or Vigilance Clearance Certificate or both within time due to genuine reasons, they may submit an undertaking along with the application stating that the NOC and Vigilance Clearance Certificate would be submitted at the time of Written Test/ Interview as the case may be. In case the candidate fail to submit the same even at the time of Written test / Interview, the candidature would be cancelled without further notice and the candidate may not be allowed to appear for the written test/interview.
2	Whether reservation and age relaxation would be provided to candidates belonging to categories Ex-Servicemen, PWD, SC, ST and OBC-NCL	The Institute follows reservation policy as per orders of the Government of India for all categories. Age relaxation would be applicable to Ex-Servicemen and PWD candidates as per the Government Orders. SC/ST/OBC candidates would be given age relaxation for posts reserved for such categories.
3	Whether age relaxation is provided to serving Government Servants?	No. NID Haryana presently has no policy for providing age relaxation for its own employees or employees of any Government or Government organisations.
4.	Is it compulsory to get the Photo in the application form attested by a Gazetted officer?	Yes. However, genuine cases would be considered by the competent authority for relaxation if sufficient proof is attached with the application regarding the genuine reason due to which the candidate was not able to get the photo attested by a Gazetted officer.
5	Which Degree would be treated as equivalent to B.Com	A Graduate Degree awarded by a UGC recognised University or any other Institute authorised by the Government to award such Degree in in Commerce/Finance/Accounts of minimum 3 years' duration would be treated as equivalent to B.Com.
6	Whether separate applications are to be forwarded when applying for the same post on Direct Recruitment as well as Contract? Whether separate fee to be paid in such cases?	No. Single application with single payment of fee would suffice.
7	What would be the pattern and syllabus for written test?	This would be published on website soon.
